Note: Although WLV has no restrictions as to arrival and departure dates, WLV's official rental period for Spring 2018 is from January 3, 2018 to May 11, 2018 [four months plus 9 days minimum contract]: Check out is before 12 noon, May 12, 2018]. Additional rent for early arrivals before January 3, 2018 or stays beyond May 11, 2018 is set forth in Section X below.

() double occupancy*: **\$1,784.50** - [\$415.00 per month (\$1,660.00) plus 9 days (\$124.50)]
2. Option 2: Two Bedroom Unit**
() a private bedroom: **\$2,580.00** - [\$600.00 per month (\$2,400.00) plus 9 days (\$180.00)]
() double occupancy in one bedroom* [See rate above for 1 bedroom, double occupancy]

***Double occupancy is available only if you have a preferred roommate (please list on last page) to share the bedroom.**

****For the two bedroom unit, these options are only available if at least one other person rents the other bedroom.**

III. Terms and Conditions To Reserve Your Option.

A. For Applicants Who Intend to Pay In Full.

1. Applicant will submit \$300.00 together with this application and shall pay the rent per the option selected above on or before 12/01/17 to our office.

B. For Applicants Who Intend To Pay By Installments:

1. Applicant will submit \$525.00 together with this application and (\$500.00 as a security deposit and a non-refundable fee of \$25.00 for the processing and drafting of a Promissory Note) to our office.
2. The first installment payment per the option selected above in Section II B., will be due on or before 12/01/17.
 - a) Said Note will carry an interest rate of one percent per month (12% per annum) commencing 01/03/18, and based on the balance owed after the first installment payment is made and shall be paid in 3 installments per the dates as stated in Section II B above. All payments subject to Hawaii General Excise Tax and fees for late payments.

IV. Reservations and Cancellations.

A. Consideration:

1. Applicant hereby tenders \$300.00 (or \$525.00 for students intending to pay by installments) payable to WLW along with this application to reserve a space. Generally, date of receipt determines priority in obtaining the option selected subject to timely rental payment by the deadlines noted herein.

Upon execution and receipt of the rental payment on or before 12/01/17 said deposit will be converted to a security deposit to cover damages and loss of personal property, cleaning expenses, and failure to pay other charges that is attributed to applicant and cancellation fees.

B. Cancellations:

1. Applicant agrees that if he/she cancels a confirmed reservation for any reason, the deposit or portions of it shall become non-refundable as follows:
 - a) \$50.00 if cancelled prior to December 1, 2017.
 - b) \$75.00 if cancelled for any reason after December 1, 2017.
 - c) Cancellation After The Commencement Date When the Term Begins:
 - (1) Within 10 days: One month's rent forfeited as and for liquidated damages.
 - (2) After 10 days: All rental deposits paid in (or amounts owed on a Note), shall become forfeited as and for liquidated damages (unless you find someone to assume your position, subject to WLW's approval of said tenant at their sole discretion).

(This is a one-time courtesy ride that the Landlord provides for our new student tenants.)

VI. Procedure as to Assignment of Unit:

- WLW has sole discretion to assign applicant (or transfer after assignment) to a particular unit. Applicant may request WLW for a transfer to another unit for good cause and subject to availability.

VII. Rules and Regulations.

- House Rules and Regulations will be issued to you upon arrival or see it on our website at www.wlvapartments.com. Quiet hours are strictly enforced.
- #### B.
- UHH Rules and Regulations concerning housing and student discipline including eviction procedures are also applicable to WLW residents. Each applicant is solely responsible to review these rules and regulations provided by UHH. WLW has complete authority to discipline any student for violation of any House Rule including the right to evict and acknowledges that the Hawaii Landlord Tenant Code as to eviction and termination and security deposits does not apply.

VIII. Transportation Between Apartment Complex and Campus and Shopping Center.

The Hawai'i County currently provides a discounted bus fare of \$1.00 for HELE ON bus service for students with a valid student ID, seniors age 60 and over with a valid ID, and disabled people with a Disability Bus Pass. It is free for children under 5 years of age. It is \$2.00 for all others. Bus schedules and routes can be

found on-line at www.heleonbus.org. The website also has information on the County's subsidized Shared Ride Taxi Program. Taxi coupons can be purchased by mail or in person from the Hawai'i County's Mass Transit Agency. Please check their website for more information.

IX. What is Included and Excluded in Rent.

- A. **Tenant is responsible for setting up and paying for telephone, cable TV and Internet services.**
Used TV sets are available for rent for \$10.00 per month or \$35.00 per semester, subject to availability.
- B. Units include, a full size refrigerator, a gas or electric range, a microwave oven, dishes, pots, pans, basic utensils, twin bed (a double bed request is subject to availability on a first come first serve basis), chest of drawers, futon sofa / love seat (or equivalent furniture), dining table and chairs, study desk with chair, a ceiling fan, and other miscellaneous items that may differ in each unit such as book cases, TV stand, end tables, lamps and microwave stands.
- C. **Utilities (except telephone) are included, however, electricity charges is covered up to a maximum of \$50.00 per month for 1 bedroom units that have gas ranges and \$60.00 for units with electric ranges (in Wailoa only) and for all 2 bedroom units. 2 bedroom units in Wailoa will have a \$70.00 maximum.** Since cooking is done mostly by gas and heated water by gas and solar power, one-third to one-fourth of our units go below the amount for electric charges. Pro-rata charges will be assessed for 2 or more occupants. (A copy of the electric bill will be provided when the tenant goes over the maximum allowed.)
- D. Applicant will have to provide own linens, towels, pillow, soap, paper towels, toilet tissue, & cleaning products.
- E. Laundry service (there are coin operated washers and dryers available on-site).
